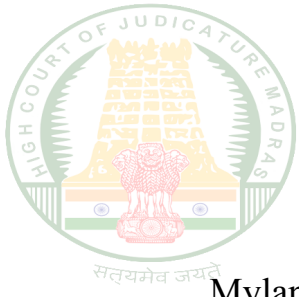

C.M.P.No.7950 of 2023:

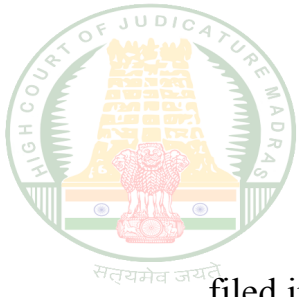
