No. 145 of 2019 on the file of the learned XIX Additional City Civil and Sessions Judge, Chennai, thereby returned the petition filed by the petitioner under Section 94(1) r/w 256(3) of BNSS 2023 to produce the Chief and Cross deposition of PW5 and PW14 in J.C. No. 199 of 2018 by the learned XII Metropolitan Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Kellys, Chennai.

2. The Xerox copy of the deposition of PW5 and PW14 in J.C. No. 199 of 2018 on the file of XII Metropolitan Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Kellys, Chennai were already marked through the investigation officer.
