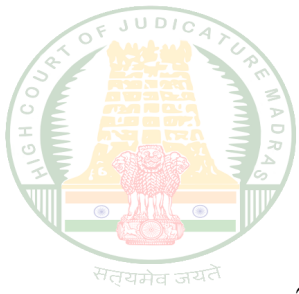

ORDER

Today, when the matter was taken up for hearing, learned Special Government Pleader appearing on behalf of the respondents submitted that, this Court vide order dated 22.08.2024 issued a direction to respondents to implement the proceedings of the first respondent dated 29.12.2023.
