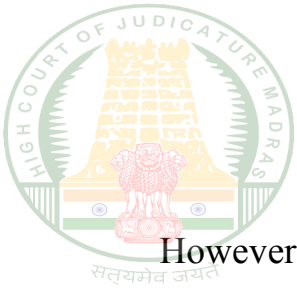

The petitioner was granted anticipatory bail in Crl.MP.No.2991 of 2024 by an order dated 30.10.2024 by the Principal District and Sessions Judge, Chengalpattu, on condition that the petitioner shall appear before the Judicial Magistrate No.II, Tambaram on every Monday at 10.30 a.m for a period of two months. Thereafter, the petitioner filed a relaxation petition in Crl.M.P.No.159 of 2025. The Principal District and Sessions Judge, Chengalpattu, by an order dated 21.01.2025 dismissed the petition, since the petitioner had complied with the condition only for two weeks. Hence, this Criminal Original Petition.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent would submit that the petitioner has been complying with the conditions regularly.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the order dated 21.01.2025 in Crl.M.P.No.159 of 2025, on the file of the Principal District and Sessions Judge, Chengalpattu, is hereby set aside and the condition imposed on the petitioner in Crl.MP.No.2991 of 2024 dated 30.10.2024, on the file of the Principal District and Sessions Judge, Chengalpattu, is totally relaxed.
