NO.EPS/Court Case/TN/IV dated 25.06.2018 and quash the same insofar as prospective effect is concerned and further issue a direction directing to the first and fifth respondents to take necessary actions according with the order of the Hon’ble Supreme Court of India in Special Leave Petition Nos.33032-33033 of 2015 dated 04.10.2016 and to get approval from the concern Government of India as well as Government of Tamil Nadu as per the Provisions of the Employees Provident Fund and Miscellaneous Provision Act and the Employees Pension Scheme 1955 and pass orders.
