ORDER

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed by the petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 04.03.2025, seeking bail in Crime No.19 of 2025 registered for the offence under Sections 296(b), 126(2), 115(2), 281, 125(a), 351(3) of BNS Act [294(b), 339, 321, 279, 336, 337 and



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506(i) of IPC subsequently altered into Sections 296(b), 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109 of BNS Act [294(b), 339, 321, 324, 326, 307 of IPC].

2. The case of the prosecution is that due to previous enmity, the petitioner along with other accused waylaid the defacto complainant and his mother, while they were riding the motor cycle, abused them in filthy language and assaulted them and caused injuries.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the allegations are false and in any case the petitioner is in custody from 04.03.2025; that the co-accused were granted bail by this Cour and that further custody is not required for the purpose of investigation. Hence, he prayed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

4. Learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) reiterated the prosecution case and submitted that the petitioner has no previous cases. He further confirmed the fact the co-accused were enlarged on bail.



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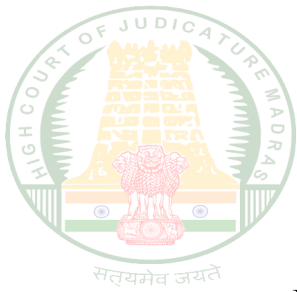
5. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) for the respondent Police and perused the materials available on record.

6. Considering the nature of allegations; the fact that the co-accused were enlarged on bail by this Court; the period of incarceration; the fact that the petitioner has no bad antecedents and since further custody is not required for the purpose of investigation, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

7. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only)** with **two sureties**, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned **Judicial Magistrate No.II, Attur** and on further conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police everyday at 10.30 a.m., for a period of one week and thereafter report before the learned Judicial



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Magistrate No.II, Attur on every Monday and Thursday at 10.30.a.m.,until further orders;

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]***;

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 B.N.S.
