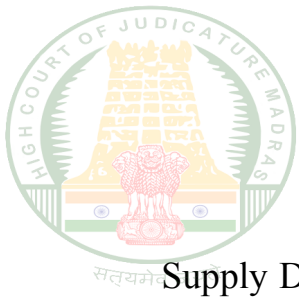

ORDER

2. It is stated that an order had been passed which has to be challenged by



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the petitioner but the learned counsel states that the order had been passed by the 2nd respondent who is not competent.

3. Hence, the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to challenge the said order on all grounds by filing a separate writ petition. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is also closed.
