The petitioner had also claimed that the medical leave had been wrongly adjusted from the earned leave account. In this regard the petitioner had given a representation on 08.02.2024.

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3.A direction is given to the 3rd respondent to examine the service register of the petitioner and examine the last drawn pay of the petitioner and also whether the medical leave had been adjusted with earned leave and pass appropriate order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Accordingly, this Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs.
