ORDER

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed by the petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 10.02.2025, seeking bail in Crime No.4 of 2025 registered for the offence under Section 11(4) and 12 of POCSO Act, 2012 and 75, 76, 77, 351(3) of BNSS Act, 2023 [354A, 354B, 354C and 506 of IPC] and 67(B) of Information Technology Act, 2000.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner had sexually abused the younger daughter of the de facto complainant and shared nude photos of the victim girl.

3.Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the



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petitioner is an innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in this case.

He also submitted that the petitioner is in custody from 10.02.2025 and he is ready to abide by any stringent condition that may be imposed by this Court. Hence, he prayed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

4.Learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent police, while opposing for grant of bail to the petitioner, reiterated the prosecution case. He also produced the statement of the victim girl recorded under Section 183(5) of BNSS.

5.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) for the respondent Police and perused the materials available on record including the statement of the victim girl recorded under Section 183(5) of BNSS..

6.It is seen from the statement of the victim girl recorded under Section 183(5) of BNSS that the the complaint was filed under the compulsion of the victim girl's brother. Considering the nature of allegations, period of incarceration and since further custody is not required for the purpose of interrogation, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

7.Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only)** with



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two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge for exclusive trial of cases under POCSO Act, 2012, Ranipet, and on further conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent Police, everyday at 10.30 a.m., until further orders;

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]*;

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of B.N.S.
