ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed in the nature of a Mandamus seeking a direction to pay interest at 6% per annum towards the belated settlement of terminal benefits like Provident Fund, Gratuity, Commutation of Pension and Earned Leave Salary and also to pay the leave encashment amount and last 11 days salary to the petitioner.

2.In the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition it had been stated that the petitioner had joined the 2nd respondent Corporation as Technical Assistant and retired from service on attaining the age of superannuation on 31.05.2023. The petitioner was serving as Senior Grade Driver. It had been stated that the Provident Fund, Gratuity, Commutation of Pension, and Earned Leave was paid after 21 months from the date of retirement. For that 21 months, the petitioner seeks interest at 6% per annum. In this connection, the petitioner had given a representation dated 14.03.2025.



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4. With the above observations, this Writ Petition stands disposed of.
