2. Admittedly, the petitioner was a party to the order dated 09.10.2018 made in CRP (NPD) Nos.296 and 2070 of 2007.

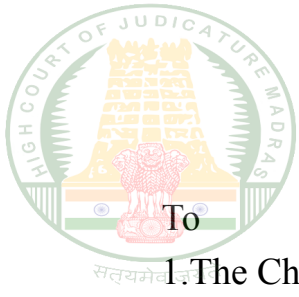
