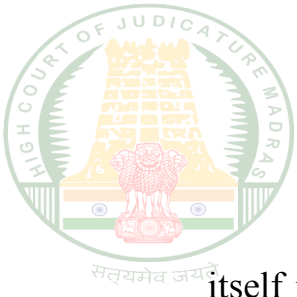

PRAYER: Criminal Original Petition is filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, to direct the learned Sessions Judge, Special Court for SC/ST Act Cases, Villupuram to consider the bail application of the petitioner on the very same day of his surrender

ORDER

This petition is filed for a direction to the learned Sessions Judge, Special Court for SC/ST Act Cases, Villupuram to consider the bail applications of the petitioners on the very same day of their surrender itself in connection with crime No.33 of 2025 pending on the file of the second respondent police.

2. In view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and also taking into consideration of the possibility of misusing the pious intention of the Parliament against innocent persons, there shall be a direction to the learned Sessions Judge, Special Court for SC/ST Act Cases, Villupuram, to consider the petitioners' bail applications, preferably on the same day of their surrender in connection with Crime



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No.33 of 2025 and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity to the victim under Section 15(a) of the SC/ST Act. The petitioners shall surrender before the concerned jurisdictional Court within a period of fifteen days from the date of the receipt of a copy of this Order.

3. It is needless to say that the Court below while disposing the bail petitions, shall look into the gravity of the offence, previous antecedents of the petitioners and pass orders. Mere direction issued by this Court to consider the bail petitions on the same day, does not amount to consider it favourably.

4. With the above direction, the Criminal Original Petition stands disposed of.
