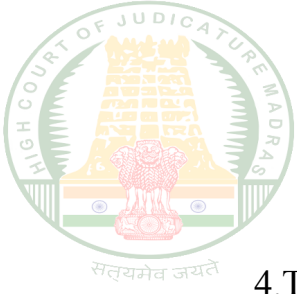
ORDER

2. Heard Mr. Vijayan Subramanian, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, Mr. P. Sathish, learned Additional Government Pleader appearing on behalf of respondents 1 and 2 and Mrs. S. R. Sumathy, learned Standing Counsel appearing on behalf of the 3rd respondent.

3. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the fact that already an Award has been passed in this case by the 2nd respondent and the same was put to challenge before this Court in W.P.No.18811 of 2022 and this Court disposed of the writ petition by an order dated 21.07.2022, directing the petitioner to file an appeal before the District Collector under Section 3G(5) of the Act and pursuant to which the petitioner also filed an appeal before the 1st respondent on May 2023 and the enquiry was commenced by the 1st respondent and the National Highways Authority of India has also filed a counter in this case, there shall be a direction to the 1st respondent to pass final orders, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
