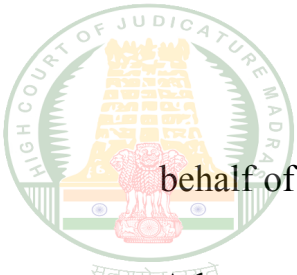

ORDER

This writ petition has been filed for issue of writ of mandamus directing the 1st and 2nd respondent to act upon the online application submitted by the petitioner on 03.02.2025, wherein, the petitioner is seeking for the survey of the subject property and for demarcation of boundaries.

2.Heard Mr.M.R.Jothimanian, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, Mr.P.Sathish, learned Additional Government Pleader appearing on



behalf of the respondents 1 and 2 and Mr.V.J.Priyadarsana, learned Government

Advocate appearing on behalf of the 3rd respondent.

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3.The petitioner is placing reliance upon the Judgement and Decree passed in the Civil proceedings in order to trace the right over the subject property measuring an extent of 1.45 acres. The petitioner submitted an online application on 03.02.2025 after paying the necessary charges and sought for the survey of the subject property for demarcation of boundaries. Since the same was not acted upon, the present writ petition has been filed before this Court.

4.Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the materials placed before this Court, there shall be a direction to the 1st and 2nd respondents to act upon the online application submitted by the petitioner on 03.02.2025 and conduct the survey in the subject property based on the documents relied upon by the petitioner. If there are any rival claimants, such survey shall be conducted in their presence. If there is any likelihood of law and order problem, the 3rd respondent shall give police protection. This process shall



be completed, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

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5. This writ petition is disposed of with the above directions. No Costs.
