ORDER

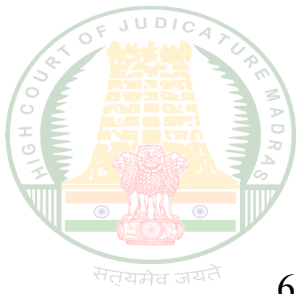
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3. At this juncture, the learned counsel appearing for the first respondent would submit that they will conclude the enquiry within a reasonable time.

In view of the above submission, without going into the merits of this Writ Petition, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the first respondent to conclude the enquiry and pass final orders on its own merits and in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
