This order will now dispose of the captioned 'Writ Miscellaneous Petition' [hereinafter 'WMP' for the sake of brevity].

2. Captioned WMP has been filed with prayer to dispense with production of 'original impugned proceedings signed on 04.03.2025' [hereinafter 'impugned proceedings' for the sake of brevity, convenience and clarity].

3. Mr. P. Vijendran, learned counsel on record for writ petitioners, is before this Court.

4. Learned counsel on record for writ petitioners, advertent to support affidavit, submitted that the impugned proceedings signed on 04.03.2025, was served on none of the writ petitioners and hence, the writ petitioners were not able to file the original impugned proceedings. Learned counsel drew the attention of this Court to relevant part of support affidavit in W.P.No.13780 of 2025, which reads as follows:
