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JUDGMENT

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The learned counsel for the appellant seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the appeal stating that the State Insurance Corporation on 24.07.2025, has introduced an Amnesty Scheme for the purpose of one time settlement of all the disputes pending as on 31.03.2025 and he has also made an endorsement to that effect.

2. The learned counsel would also submit that the appellant is willing to avail the scheme for one time settlement in order to give quietus to the issue.

3. In view of the above, the appellant is permitted to withdraw this appeal in order to avail the benefit of Amnesty Scheme as mentioned supra.

4. Recording the aforestated submissions, this Civil Miscellaneous Appeal stands dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file the Appeal afresh in the event of the appellant's case is not considered as per New Amnesty Scheme dated 24.07.2025. There is no order as to costs. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
