4. Ms.Nazira Banu, seeks permission of this Court to withdraw this appeal and she made an endorsement to that effect. Permission is granted.

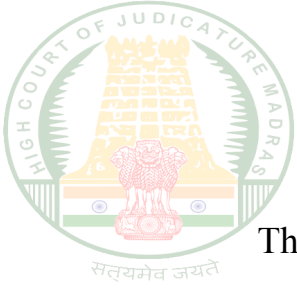
5. This Civil Miscellaneous Appeal is dismissed as withdrawn in the light of the settlement already arrived at.
