COMMON ORDER

In all these writ petitions, the petitioner has assailed the action of respondents in initiating the disciplinary action against him.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that subsequent to filing of the writ petitions, the respondents having passed an order dated 09.10.2023 cancelling the petitioner's initial appointment itself. He further submits that in view of the subsequent decision of the respondents, the cause in the present writ petition does not survive for consideration.

3. Learned Additional Government Pleader for the first respondent and learned counsel for the second and third respondents did not dispute the aforesaid submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.



4. In view of the aforesaid submission and taking note of the fact that by a subsequent action, the respondents having cancelled the appointment of petitioner itself, and the said proceeding is under challenge before this Court, this Court is of the view that the cause in the writ petition does not survive for consideration.

5. Accordingly, these writ petitions are closed as infructuous. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed. No costs.
