ORDER

The instant writ petition has been filed with a prayer for issuing a Mandamus to direct the respondents to disburse the payments relating to difference of gratuity, EL surrender as per 13th wage settlement and last month 10 days salary amounts and considering the petitioner's representation dated 17.02.2025 within the stipulated time as may be fixed by this Court.

2. It is the submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is entitled to revise the petitioner's wage in terms of the 13th wage settlement with effect from 01.09.2016 and to pay the difference in payment of terminal benefits such as gratuity, EL surrender and last month 10 days salary amount. It is also the submission of the petitioner that in this regard, she had sent representation on 17.02.2025, and the same was not considered by the respondents.

3. At this juncture, the learned Standing Counsel appearing for the respondents would fairly submit that they would consider the said

representation of the petitioner within a reasonable time.

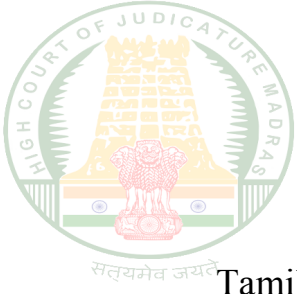
