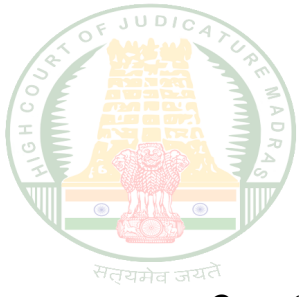
3. Memo is taken on record.
