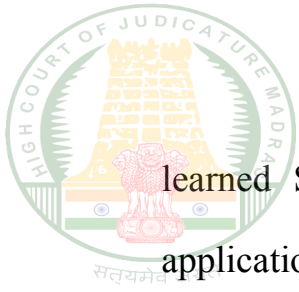
To direct the Respondent to release to the claims of the applicant before performing any further acts or deeds in relation to the project.

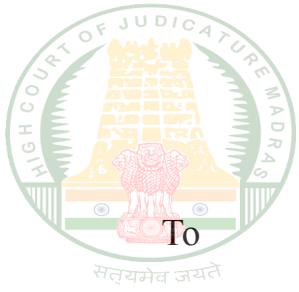
