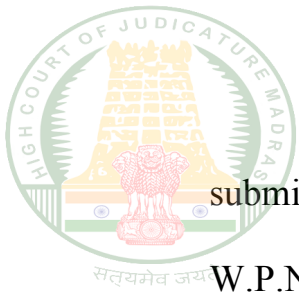
ORDER

The writ petition has been filed to direct the respondents to pay interest at the rate of 6% per annum for the belated payment of leave salary, provident fund, gratuity and commutation by considering his representation dated 24.03.2025.

2. The case of the petitioner is that, he was appointed in the first respondent Transport Corporation on 01.08.1998 and after rendering unblemished service, he retired from service on attaining the age of superannuation on 31.05.2023. However, the terminal benefits have been settled to the petitioner belatedly and no interest has been paid for the delayed period. In view of the same, the petitioner submitted representation to the first respondent dated 24.03.2025, to pay interest for the delayed period. Since the same was not considered, the present writ petition has been filed.

3. The learned Standing Counsel for the respondents would fairly

submits that in view of the similar order passed by this Court in W.P.Nos.40031, 33742 and 35806 of 2024, they are willing to pay the interest at the rate of 6% per annum for the belated payment of the eligible and admissible amount.

4. Heard the learned counsel for both sides and perused the materials available on record.

5. In view of the above submission of the learned Standing Counsel, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the respondents to pay interest at the rate of 6% per annum for the belated payment of admissible terminal benefits from the date of retirement till the date of actual disbursal of the terminal benefits of the petitioner within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
