ORDER

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2. Heard Mr.A.Ilaya Perumal, learned counsel for petitioner and Mr.M.R.Gokulkrishnan, learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for respondents 1 to 4.

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the fact that the representation made by the petitioner was received by the first respondent and it was forwarded to the second respondent, there shall be a direction to the second respondent to act upon the same and pass orders on its own merits and in accordance with law after affording opportunity to respondents 5 to 7 within a period of eight (8) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

This writ petition is disposed of with the above direction. No costs.
