PRAYER: This criminal original petition has been filed under Section 483 of BNSS to enlarge the petitioners on bail in Crime No.87 of 2025 pending investigation on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed by the petitioners, who were arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 23.03.2025, seeking bail



in Crime No.87 of 2025 registered for the offence under Sections 296(b), 115(2), 132 of BNS, 2023 and Section 4-A of TNP Act.

2.It is the case of the prosecution that on 22.03.2025 at about 06.30 p.m., when the defacto complainant and their officials were on patrol duty near Shevaroy's Temple, the petitioners were consuming liquor and causing nuisance to public; that when the defacto complainant questioned the same, the petitioners had abused him in filthy language, assaulted him with hands and caused injuries. Hence, the case.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the petitioners are innocent; that the injured has been discharged from the hospital and that the petitioners are in custody from 23.03.2025 and hence, further custody of the petitioners is not required and sought for bail.

4.Per contra, the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) reiterated the prosecution case and confirmed the fact that the injured has been discharged from the hospital and submitted that the first petitioner has no bad antecedents and the second petitioner has one previous case and he is on bail in that case.



5.Heard the learned counsel on either side and perused the materials available on record.

6.Considering the nature of allegations, period of incarceration, the fact that the first petitioner has no bad antecedents and the second petitioner is on bail in the previous case, the fact that the injured has been discharged from the hospital, and since further custody of the petitioners is not required for the purpose of investigation, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.

7.Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their executing separate bond for a sum of **Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only) each** with **two sureties**, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the **District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate, Yercaud**, and on further conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

[b] the petitioners shall report before the respondent Police, **everyday at 10.30 a.m., until further orders;**



[c] the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[d] the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]***;

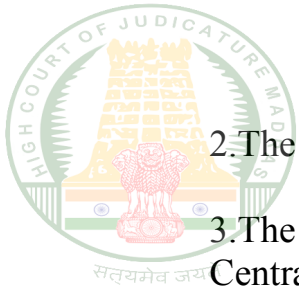
[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 B.N.S.
