ORDER

Today, the matter is listed under the caption "for being mentioned" at the instance of learned counsel for petitioner.

2. It is submitted by the learned counsel for petitioner that the aforesaid writ petition was disposed of vide order dated 02.06.2025. It is further submitted that they had inadvertently made an error in respect of name of village and Taluk in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition and would request that the same may be corrected as "Avinashi Village, Avinashi Taluk" instead of Kasigoundenpudur, Velayudampalayam Village, Avinashi Taluk in the prayer, cause title and order dated 02.06.2025. To which the learned counsel for respondents did not seriously object.

3. Heard both sides.

4. In view of the said submission made by the learned counsel for petitioner, the address of the subject property in prayer, cause title and paragraphs 2 and 3 of the order dated 02.06.2025 shall stand substituted as follows:

2. The present writ petition is filed praying for a writ of mandamus to direct respondent Nos.1 and 2 to make necessary correction in respect of the joint patta bearing patta Nos.1825, 1826, 1726 and 687 in Survey Nos.324/19, 324/20, 324/10 and 324/9 respectively with regard to the survey No.324/2023 with an extent of 2 Acre 88 Cents situated at Avinashi Village, Avinashi Taluk in view of the representation dated 18.11.2024.

3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that respondent No.2 in respect of Survey No.324/23, to an extent of 2 Acre 88 Cents situated at Avinashi Village, Avinashi Taluk, issued joint patta in Patta Nos.1825, 1826, 1726 and 687 in Survey Nos.324/19, 324/20, 324/10 and 324/9 respectively. Therefore, the petitioner filed a representation on 18.11.2024 seeking correction of patta before respondent No.1. However, the said representation has not been considered so far by respondent No.1. Aggrieved by the same, the petitioner has come before this Court. "



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5. Except the above modification, all other paragraphs made in the earlier order dated 02.06.2025 shall remain intact. Registry is directed to carry out necessary corrections and issue the corrected order copy to the parties forthwith.

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ORDER

By consent of learned counsel on both sides, this writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2. The present writ petition is filed praying for a writ of mandamus to direct respondent Nos.1 and 2 to make necessary correction in respect of the joint patta bearing patta Nos.1825, 1826, 1726 and 687 in Survey Nos.324/19, 324/20, 324/10 and 324/9 respectively with regard to the survey No.324/2023 with an extent of 2 Acre 88 Cents situated at Kasigoundenpudur, Velayudampalayam Village, Avinashi Taluk in view of the representation dated 18.11.2024.

3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that respondent No.2 in respect of Survey No.324/23, to an extent of 2 Acre 88 Cents situated at Kasigoundenpudur, Velayudampalayam Village, Avinashi Taluk, issued joint patta in Patta Nos.1825, 1826, 1726 and 687 in Survey Nos.324/19, 324/20, 324/10 and 324/9 respectively. Therefore, the petitioner filed a representation on 18.11.2024 seeking correction of patta before respondent No.1. However, the said representation has not been considered so far by respondent No.1. Aggrieved by the same, the petitioner has come before this Court.



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4. At the outset, it was submitted by the learned Additional Government Pleader for respondents that they would consider and pass orders on the petitioner's representation dated 18.11.2024, within a time frame fixed by this Court, which was agreed to by the learned counsel for petitioner.

5. In view of the same, taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the limited relief sought for in this Writ Petition, there shall be a direction to the 1st respondent, to consider the representation dated 18.11.2024 on its own merits and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law, after affording reasonable opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and any other interested persons/stake holders, including adjacent land owners, within a period of eight (8) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any views with regard to the merits of the representation and it is open to the concerned respondent to consider the representation on its own merits and in accordance with law.

6. Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
