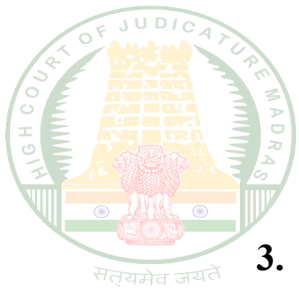

2. Mr.K.Ezhumalai, learned Counsel for the petitioner and Mr.K.Moorthy, learned Counsel for the first respondent are present.

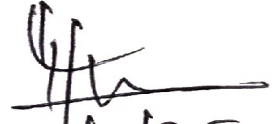


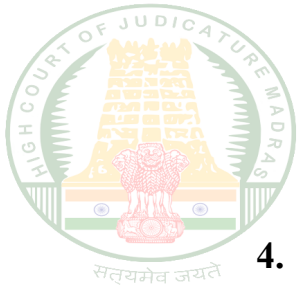
