PRAYER

Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a writ of Mandamus, to direct the respondents 2 and 3 to pursue legal action as a remedy for violations of the law for misusing the Court name, to conclude the departmental inquiry, and to enforce appropriate disciplinary measures, including the dismissal of the respondents 4 & 5 from service for the reason mentioned in present writ petition. This action is warranted due to the abuse of power, procedural misconduct, suppression of facts, and the creation of false entries in official records. Furthermore, it addresses the misuse of authority through the dissemination of misleading information, deceiving higher officials, and falsifying records in written communications to superiors, including Indian Police Service(IPS) officers such as the Chairperson of the National Commission of Women in New Delhi, the Director General of Police in Tamil Nadu, the Commissioner of Police for Law and Order (North), the Joint Commissioner of Police for the West Zone, the Deputy Commissioner of Police for Pulianthope District, and the Assistant Commissioner of Police for Sembium. This directive aims to ensure that justice is upheld in light of the misuse of the Court's name by Government official against the respondents 4



and 5 during the year 2021 for misleading all the IPS officers stating and by misusing the Court name that there is a Court direction to file the FIR in Cr.No.10/2021 under Sections 498(A), 406 and 506(i) of IPC on December 3, 2021. It is important to note that there has been no such direction from any of the Court to date and take consequent action thereupon.

ORDER

The present writ petition is listed today under the caption “For being mentioned”.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that in Paragraph No.2 of the order dated 23.06.2025, instead of respondents 1 to 3, it is mentioned as 5th and 6th respondents.

3. Considering the submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner, Paragraph No.2 of the order is modified as follows,

*“2. The petitioner is appearing as a party-in-person would vehemently submit that the **respondents 1 to 3**, on the false information provided by the 4th and 5th respondents, National Commission for Women instructed the Higher Officials those who are arrayed as respondents 1 to 3 herein to take*



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action against this petitioner. It is the further submission of the petitioner that when he received reply under RTI, it has been categorically stated that the FIR was not registered on the basis of any Court direction. In this connection, the petitioner has sent a representation on 12.08.2023 to take action against the respondents 4 and 5 and such representation is yet to be considered by the respondents.”

4. Registry is directed to carry out the aforesaid corrections and issue fresh order copy.
