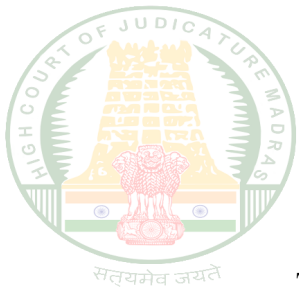

ORDER

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The relief sought in this writ petition is to call for the records of the Order dated 06.02.2025 bearing No.33AACCD2292C1Z6/2017-18 issued by the Respondent along with the Summary of the Order in Form GST DRC 08 dated 06.02.2025 bearing Reference No.ZD330225060860O passed for the tax period between July 2017 to March 2018 and quash the same.

2. The learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted that though this writ petition has been filed for the aforesaid relief, the Petitioner has now restricted the relief and seeks liberty to file an appeal before the concerned Appellate Authority.

3. The learned Government Advocate (Tax) appearing for the Respondent submitted that she has no objection for granting such liberty to the Petitioner.

4. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court is of the opinion that it would be appropriate to dismiss this writ petition and grant liberty to the Petitioner to file an appeal before the

concerned Appellate Authority.

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5. Accordingly, this Writ Petition is dismissed and liberty is granted to the Petitioner to file an appeal before the concerned Appellate Authority, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. On filing of such appeal by the Petitioner, the concerned Appellate Authority shall consider the same and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording an opportunity of personal hearing to the Petitioner, as expeditiously as possible. No costs.
