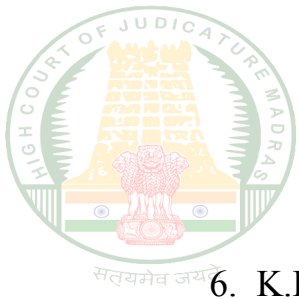

### **ORDER**

The writ petition has been filed to direct the respondent No.1 to dispose of the appeal proceedings in No.9487863/ G/ 2025 in accordance with law.

2.The petitioner has suffered an award at the hands of the Arbitrator of the Chits Central, Chennai, in ARC No.45/2022 on 15.02.2023.



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Aggrieved by the same, he has preferred an appeal before the first respondent in reference No.9487863/G/2025.

It is made clear that this order will not stand in the way of the executing court to proceed further in E.P.No.1516 of 2024. It is upto the petitioner to move an appropriate stay application before the appellate fora.
