ORDER

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the petitioners have sent their representation to count their past service for the purpose of pension and General Provident Fund and the same is yet to be considered.

Though there is disputed facts between the parties, taking into consideration of the fact that the representation made by the petitioners is yet to be considered, this Court without going into the merits of the matter, deems it appropriate to direct the respondents to consider the representation dated 12.02.2025 on it's own merits and in accordance with law, within a period of eight (8) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. In the result, this Writ Petition is disposed of with the above directions. There shall be no order as to costs.
