ORDER

The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offence under Section 318 (4) of BNS in crime No. not known of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

Till the conclusion of the enquiry, the respondent police shall not arrest the petitioners.
