ORDER

The writ petition has been filed to direct the respondents to pay difference in gratuity and leave salary based on 14th wage settlement dated 24.08.2022 and unpaid last retirement month 10 days salary with 10% interest to the petitioner.

2. The case of the petitioner is that, he joined the respondent Transport Corporation as Tradesman on 11.08.1992 and retired from service on 31.05.2022. The petitioner made a representation to the respondents dated 28.02.2025, to pay the difference in gratuity and leave salary based on 14th wage settlement dated 24.08.2022 and unpaid last retirement month 11 days salary. The said representation is pending on the file of the respondents. Hence the present writ petition is filed.

3. Learned Standing Counsel for the respondent Corporation would submit that they would settle the eligible amount to the petitioner.
