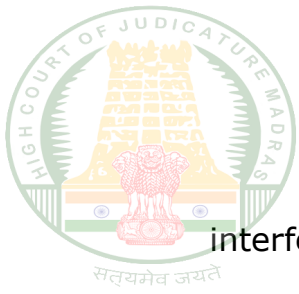
Prayer:
