ORDER

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offence under Sections 296(b), 118(1) and 351(3) of BNS, in connection with the case in Crime No.Not known of 2025, seeks anticipatory bail.

Till the conclusion of the enquiry, the respondent police shall not arrest the petitioner.
