3. When the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents, on written instructions, submits that already the application of the petitioner has been acted upon and for conducting survey, date has been fixed on 12.05.2025.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case that already a date has been fixed for survey, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the 1st respondent to pass orders on the representation dated 24.04.2025 and complete the process within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. 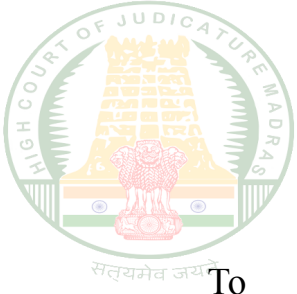
