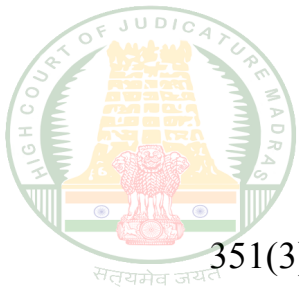
PRAYER: - The Criminal Original Petition is filed under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, (BNSS) 2023, praying to enlarge the petitioner on bail in Crime No.163 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 15.04.2025, for the offences punishable under Sections 296(b), 132,



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351(3) of BNS, 2023 and Section 25(1-A) of Arms Act, 1959, in Crime No.163 of 2025, on the file of the respondent, seeks bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on 15.04.2025, the respondent police conducted routine vehicle checkup and when they intercepted the petitioner's vehicle, the petitioner abused the police officials in filthy language and intimidated them and took away the vehicle. Hence, the case.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case. He would further submit that no such offence is committed by the petitioner and it is put up case. He would further submit that the petitioner has no bad antecedents for the past five years. He would further submit that the petitioner is in custody from 15.04.2025. He would further submit that the petitioner is ready to abide by any stringent condition that may be imposed by this Court. Hence, he prays for grant of bail to the petitioner.



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4.Per contra, the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) reiterated the prosecution case and submitted that there are nine previous cases pending against the petitioner. However, the learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that there is no previous case after 2020.

5.Heard both side learned counsel and perused the materials available on record.

6.Considering the nature of allegations, the period of incarceration, the fact that the petitioner is on bail in the previous cases and since further custody of the petitioner is not required for the purpose of investigation, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to the following conditions:

7.Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only)** with **two sureties**, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the **Judicial Magistrate No.1, Thiruvallur**, and on further conditions that:



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[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

[b] the Petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period of three months and thereafter, as and when required for investigation.

[d] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

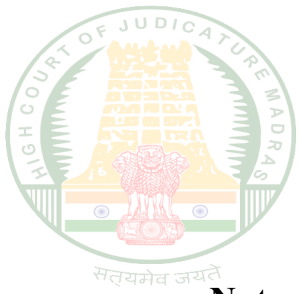
[e] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

[f] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]***;

[g] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 B.N.S.
