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ORDER

2. Heard both sides and perused the materials available on record.

3. On a reading of the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, it is seen that there was a wordy altercation between the petitioner and his father and if at all the petitioner has got any grievance with their parents, he has to work out his remedy in the manner known to law. Therefore, this Court is not inclined to give any positive direction to the respondent-Police to grant Police protection and hence, the present writ petition is not



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maintainable. Accordingly, the writ petition stands dismissed. There shall be no order as to costs.
