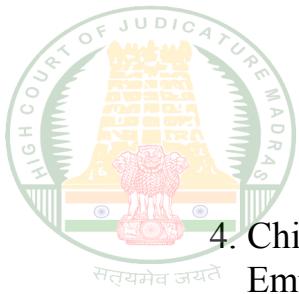

PRAYER IN W.P.No.17104 of 2020: To issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus or such other order of writ call for the records relating to the order of the Employees Provident Fund Appellate Tribunal, Chennai in EPFA 381 / 2018/A/TN-77/2017 dated 17.06.2020, quash the same the said order and further direct the first respondent to pay under the Employees Provident Funds Act, Contrinutions on the basic pay, net pay paid to the petitioner for the period 01.08.2008 to 05.11.2010 amounting to Rs.38,62,507/- with interest at the rate or 12% p.a.
