Today, this matter is listed under the caption “For Being Mentioned” at the instance of the learned counsel for the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that, this Court, vide order dated 22.05.2025 disposed of the Writ Petition. However, in the prayer of the said order, inadvertently, a typographical error has crept in wherein, the name of the Revenue Village is typed as Chitharkadu Madura Nanganallur instead of Chitharkadu Madura Nangalathur, which requires to be modified.

3. After perusing the order dated 22.05.2025, more specifically, the prayer, this Court is satisfied that the name of the Revenue Village, which is typed as Chitharkadu Madura Nanganallur should be modified as Chitharkadu Madura Nangalathur, and accordingly, in the prayer of the order dated 22.05.2025, the said corrections shall be carried out.

4. All the other observations made in the earlier order dated 22.05.2025 shall remain intact.



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5. Registry is directed to carry out the necessary correction as aforesaid in the order dated 22.05.2025 and issue fresh copy of the order to the learned counsel for the parties.

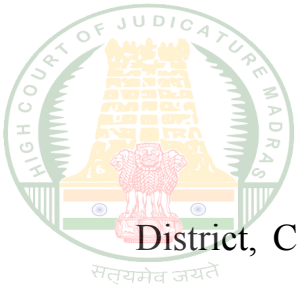
