3. Heard the learned counsel for both sides and perused the materials available on record.



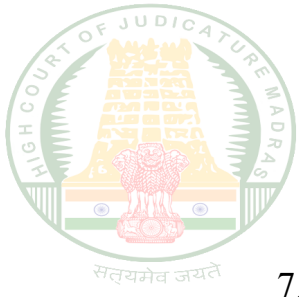

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has completed his MBBS Course and he must be admitted for his internship. However, no order has been passed by the 2nd respondent. In this connection, the petitioner has sent a representation to the respondents on 18.03.2025 and such representation is pending before them.

5. At this juncture, the learned Standing Counsel appearing for the 1st respondent, learned Standing Counsel appearing for the 2nd respondent and learned Government Advocate appearing for the 3rd respondent would submit that they will consider the petitioner's representation according to its own merits and in accordance with law, within a reasonable time.

6. In such view of the submission, without going into the merits of the writ petition, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the 2nd respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 18.03.2025 and pass orders on its own merits and in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
