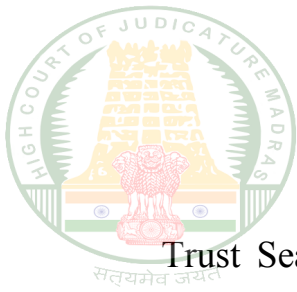

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners reports that the relief sought in this writ petition has become infructuous.

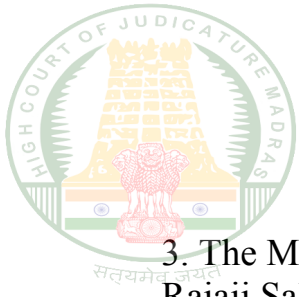
2. In view of the above submission, this Writ Petition is dismissed as infructuous. No costs. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed.
