Prayer: This Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a Writ of Declaration, declaring that the G.O.Ms.No.363 dated 23.08.2013 passed by the 1st respondent is null and void and not accordance with the order of the Supreme Court passed in Civil Appeal Nos.8848-8840 of 2012 and directed the Respondent to sanction the payment of gratuity to the pensioners for the difference of pension as per Fifth Tamil Nadu Pay Commission of scales of Pay as per the orders of the Apex Court dated 14.08.2013 in Civil Appeal No.6770 of 2013.
