Now that appeals are going to be filed against the order passed by the learned single Judge in the aforesaid batch of cases, it will be more appropriate, if the issue is dealt with by a Division Bench instead of a learned Single Judge going into the same issues all over again. This will ensure judicial discipline.

4. In view of the above, this Writ Petition stands disposed of in terms of the order dated 05.06.2025 passed in W.P.No.33079 of 2024, etc., and Batch. No costs. Consequently, the connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed.

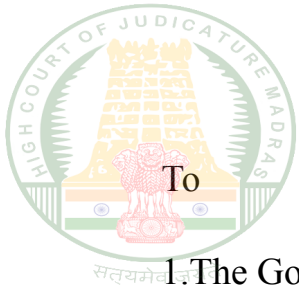
