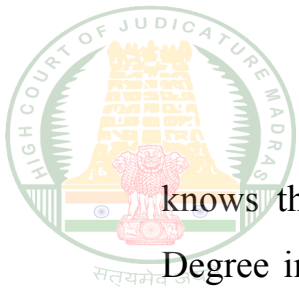

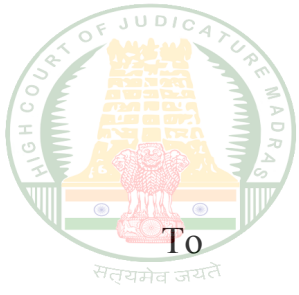
ORDER
