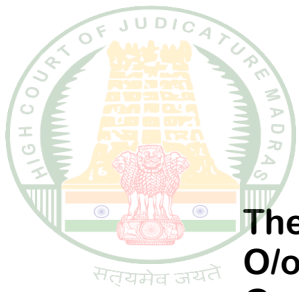

Mr.K.Karthikeyan, the learned Government Advocate (HR & CE) appearing on behalf of Respondents 1 to 3 would submit that actions have already been initiated under Section 78 of the Tamil Nadu Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowment Act, 1959 for eviction of
