PRAYER: Writ Petition (Crl.) filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India to direct the 1st respondent to issue a No Objection certificate to the petitioner to tum a SPA, i.e. cross relaxation massage in the name and style of Dhanvantri Ayurveda Siddha Clinic, at Door No.296/61, Kumarasamy Patti, Cherry Road, Salem District-7, by passing orders on the petitioner's representation dated 02.05.2025.

ORDER

The petitioner seeks a direction to the respondent police to consider his representation dated 02.05.2025 and to issue No objection Certificate to run a spa in the name of Dhanvantri Ayurveda Siddha Clinic.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) and perused the materials placed on record.

3. At the outset, this Court is of the view that such a direction as sought for by the petitioner cannot be issued. It is for the petitioner to apply for NOC through the concerned Corporation for such license. Only on such application, police verification is required. Normally, the police officials will issue NOC to the Corporation and thereafter, the Corporation grants license. Instead of making application before the concerned Corporation, the petitioner has come up before this Court by filing a writ petition seeking for a direction to the police to issue NOC and the same cannot be granted as a matter of right.



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4. Accordingly, I do not find any merits in this petition and this petition stands dismissed. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition stands closed.
