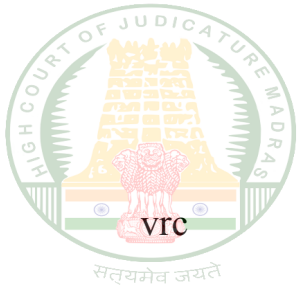
This petition has been filed to condone the delay of 166 days in preferring the present revision.
