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ORDER

The instant writ petition has been filed with a prayer for issuing a Mandamus to direct the respondent to disburse the belated payment of interest amount of provident fund, gratuity, leave salary and other unsettle benefits of leave salary surrender for the years of 2009-2011 & 2017-2018 and 10 days salary with effect from 20.09.2020 within the stipulated time as may be fixed by this Court.

2. It is the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner had retired from the services of the respondent on 31.05.2023 as Checking Inspector, and made a representation dated 24.04.2025 to the respondent seeking interest for the belated payment of the terminal benefits such as provident fund, gratuity and leave salary and to settle the leave salary surrender for the years of 2009-2011 & 2017-2018 and 10 days salary with effect from 20.09.2020 along with interest, there was no response for the same.

3. At this juncture, the learned Standing Counsel appearing for the respondent would fairly submit that they would consider the said representation of the petitioner within a reasonable time.
