This case came up for settlement before the National Lok Adalat. Both the parties are present. M/s.Ramya V. Rao, the learned



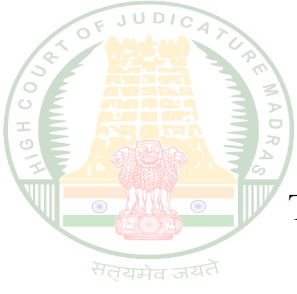
Counsel for the appellants is present. Mr.R.Nalliappan, the learned Counsel for the first respondent and Mrs.R.Sreevidhya, Insurance Company Official are also present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties, they arrived at a compromise to settle the matter as follows:

TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

Both the parties and the respective learned Counsels are also present.

2. The appellants have challenged the award amount of Rs.4,96,552/-.

3. In this case, the award has been made in MCOP No. 99 of 2019 for a sum of Rs.4,96,552/- along with further interest. The entire award amount along further interest is already deposited to the credit of MCOP No.99 of 2019 and the claimants have already withdrawn the same. Over and above the same, as full quit, another sum of Rs.3,25,000/- shall be deposited by the second respondent / Insurance Company. The said sum shall be deposited within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this award. Upon such deposit, the said sum shall be paid to the appellants without insisting of any formal application and only upon filing of a Memo and verification of identity. The apportionment will be in the same proposition as that of the Trial Court.



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The Civil Miscellaneous Appeal is disposed of accordingly.
